This scholarship was funded with a gift from Soul Passages: A Book Club which was founded by Priscilla J. Green in Hartford, CT. This scholarship is awarded in memory of Priscilla J. Green, Esq. for the examples she set in pursuing scholarly endeavors, providing public service, following the tenants of her faith, and seeking the best that life could offer. She left a lasting impression on everyone she met. Priscilla was an alumna of the Class of 1968, a Charter member of the Connecticut Chapter of the Alumni Association, and was a former member of the Board of Directors for the WU Alumni Association.

1. Criteria

- Female
- GPA – 3.0 (Verified with official transcript.)
- Class year: Junior
- Disbursement - Award to be applied to the purchase of books in the recipient's senior year.
- Geographic Location – Resident of any of the 50 states.
- Intended major – Any major accepted by Wilberforce University
- Extracurricular Activities – Public Service for at least two years previous to application.
- Renewable - No

2. Selection and Application Process

- Potential applicants will complete an essay based on a current events topic selected by Soul Passages: A Book Club each year.
- Applicants may be interviewed via Skype (or other mutual electronic means) by a panel of Soul Passages members to determine final recipient.

3. Timeline

- The application and essay topic can be accessed on the Soul Passages website at www.soulpassages.org after January 15th each year.
- Deadline to apply: March 1st each year. Completed Essay and supporting documentation must be emailed to: info@soulpassages.org
- Scholarship recipient to be announced by May 1st. Wilberforce will release the funds to be applied to book fees incurred during the recipient's senior year.
